Supporting people to work and live well

Helping you back into work



What is WorkWell?

WorkWell is a support service in Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland to help you start, stay and succeed in work.

WorkWell offers personal support to help you with any health issues so you can either stay in work or get a new job after a period of unemployment.

A specialist work and health coach will work with you to identify any

(physical and/or mental) health problems that may be affecting your chances of keeping or getting a job.

The work and health coach will be able to refer you to other health and care professionals or other sources of support to help you with any problems identified.

You can work through a plan of support with your work and health coach to help you feel healthier and more able to do your best at work.



Who can receive support?

The service is available to people in Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland with a disability or health condition who:

- Needs support to remain in work
- Needs support managing a condition in order to return to work from sickness absence, or
- Needs support to start work.

How does it work?

WorkWell focuses on early intervention and support.

You will be given an expert assessment of any health-related conditions that may be preventing you from working – along with a tailored plan to address these.

A dedicated work and health coach will work with you to get the support you need – from the NHS and partner organisations.

The work and health coach may also signpost you to other services that may be appropriate, such as debt advice for example.

You will be able to work through your plan with the work and health coach to help you get back on track and into work.

How do I access the service?

Referrals can also be made via general practitioners (local doctors), NHS colleagues, Jobcentre Plus, employers and voluntary sector representatives.

No, the service is free.
