

Is your GP practice in Leicestershire?

are available from
1 April 2026

From 1 April 2026, if you need to be seen on the same day, NHS 111 or your GP practice may offer you a new type of appointment during evenings, weekends and bank holidays.

There is nothing you need to do differently. An appointment may be offered, if it is right for you, when you contact NHS 111 or your GP practice as normal with an urgent need.

- ✔ Appointments are available at six locations weekdays and eight locations at weekends for all patients registered at Leicestershire GP practices.
- ✔ There are consistent opening times across Leicestershire:
 - Monday to Friday: 6.30pm to 8.30pm
 - Saturdays: 9am to 5pm
 - Sundays and bank holidays: 10am to 2pm.
- ✔ Appointments are with a GP and five minutes longer than standard GP appointments.
- ✔ The appointments replace those previously provided during evenings, weekends and bank holidays at Coalville, Enderby, Hinckley, Market Harborough, Lutterworth and Melton Mowbray - sometimes known as urgent care centres.
- ✔ You may also be offered an appointment at your own practice, a pharmacy (under the Pharmacy First scheme) or an urgent treatment centre.
